

# Cancer Screening Benefit



## What is the Cancer Screening Benefit?

The Cancer Screening Benefit is a covered benefit under your Cancer Insurance. It provides an annual benefit payment if you complete a covered screening test for internal cancer on or after your coverage effective date. You only need to complete one of the covered cancer screenings and may only receive one benefit payment per calendar year, even if you complete multiple screening tests. The benefit will be paid even if internal cancer is not diagnosed. To receive this benefit, you must submit proof that the internal cancer screening test was performed by providing us with documentation from your Physician. You may also receive a Cancer Screening benefit for your spouse and/or children if they are covered for Cancer Insurance and complete a screening test on or after their coverage effective date.

### 1 Getting your Cancer Screening Benefit is easy.

You, your covered spouse and/or your covered children complete a covered internal cancer screening test.

#### What screening tests are covered?

- Colonoscopy
- CA 125 test
- Chest x-ray
- Flexible sigmoidoscopy
- Mammogram
- Pap Smear
- Biopsy
- PSA
- CT scans or MRI scans
- BRCA testing
- Hemoccult stool specimen

### 3 Complete the Cancer Screening Claim form, sign and submit your claim to the address noted on the form.

### 4 Receive a benefit payment for the covered individual for whom an eligible claim was filed.

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## How can Cancer Screening Benefit help?

Every day, we learn more and more about the importance of regular cancer screenings that can help detect cancer, or the potential of developing cancer, earlier when it may be easier to treat. For example, women may get BRCA testing done if they have a family history of breast cancer to see if they have a hereditary cancer gene variant associated with an increased risk for breast cancer. The Cancer Screening Benefit encourages you to get regular screenings. The benefit payment you receive for your screening can be used to help pay for the out-of-pocket cost of the test or however you like.

## It's automatically included.

The Cancer Screening Benefit is a covered benefit under your Cancer Insurance coverage. You do not need to make a separate benefit selection.

## How much is the Cancer Screening Benefit?

Your group's plan specifies the benefit amount payable for each person who completes a Cancer Screening test.
